Regulations

The purpose of the project is mainly to test the ability to undertake independent work. Assessment is by a written report and oral examination. the report gives details of the work you have done.

The supervisor will provide a reading list and give general advice on the work required for the project and the writing of the report. You are strongly advised to give a first draft of the report to your supervisor, who would comment on format and style and may also point out any major statistical errors.

The report should be typed and printed on A4 size paper and should be submitted in a simple binder e.g. a ring binder. In addition to your own copy, which you retain, you will need to submit two copies of your project.

Each report should contain (i) a brief summary of the project; (ii) an introduction; (iii) the main project work; (iv) a bibliography.

The deadline for submission is 5pm on Thursday April 23rd 2009. I will be in my office from 3-5 to receive your project. The project may be submitted prior to this date, either directly to me or to the undergraduate secretary. You are strongly advised to submit your project before the Easter break so that the break may be used solely for revision for the written examinations in May.

There will be a weekly class for the project at a time to be arranged.
